

COVID-19 UPDATE

Act now North Lincolnshire – Covid-19 is on the rise!



North Lincolnshire is edging closer back to lockdown as the Covid-rate rises. The public has been warned that it is “crucial” to follow the restrictions and prevent local outbreaks.

22.1 cases were detected per 100,000 people in North Lincolnshire last week, a threefold rise from 8.7 for the previous week.

Penny Spring, director of Public Health at North Lincolnshire Council, has said that people need to return to the mentality of the early pandemic to stop the spread of coronavirus. “We’re on the cusp in North Lincolnshire – we’re not in dire straits yet but we’re probably as close as being so as we have been since early March.”

North Lincolnshire’s seven-day-average is behind the national average of 32.8 per 100,000 people, but has been rising.

Here in the academy most parents and carers have responded positively to our requests about social distancing at drop-off and collection times. Thank you and please continue to be responsible and considerate and SAFE.

HOME LEARNING

The possibility of classes and year groups being sent home is rising as the Covid-19 infection rate continues to rise. Your children’s teachers have sent our information about homework and details about how to access remote learning materials. I have asked them to check whether the children in their class have laptops, phones or tablets that they can use for their learning, should they have to learn from home again.

It is vitally important that children can access high-quality learning at home, as we know that nationally many did not during the 6-month lockdown, and we have seen here the impact of that in lost learning.

If you have any questions or worries about home learning, please email your children’s class teacher to discuss this and to see how we can help. In the meantime, we are showing children how to access sites and to log-in to their accounts, so that should we unfortunately have to close for any year groups in the future, they will be able to carry on their learning at home.

LOST PROPERTY

Unfortunately, we already have a large amount of lost property, including coats. As before, we cannot return some of it as it is not labelled with the child’s name. Please, please ensure that names are written in all items of clothing as this makes it easier to return to the correct child.

NURSERY

Our new children have settled into Nursery (Foundation 1) really well and look very smart in their school uniforms.

The fruit stall is now open each morning to children in Year 3-6; the fruit is 20p per item to buy. Children can bring money in each day for the fruit stall only.

FLU IMMUNISATIONS – F2 – YEAR 6

This academic year, the flu immunisations have been extended to Year 6 children as well as children in F2 to Year 5. Unfortunately, the school nurses will not be administering the immunisations at our academy until **1st December 2020**. If your child has any medical reason for the immunisation to be administered before this time, please contact your GP for further information.

The forms will be distributed on **2nd November** and should be returned by **25th November** as they will be collected by the school nurses and the 27th.
