COVID UPDATE

Public Health have picked up that there are a persistent number of Covid cases around the Frodingham area so would like to offer extra lateral flow test kits for parents. We are pleased to let you know that Oasis Academy Henderson Avenue has agreed to be a Hub where parents can collect Lateral Flow Kits hoping that this will help reduce the number of cases. Once we have taken delivery of these we will let you know how and when they can be collected.

When to self-isolate:

Self-isolate immediately for 10 days if:

- Any member of your household has any symptoms of COVID-19 (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- a member of your household has tested positive for COVID-19 – this means they have the virus
- someone in your childcare or support bubble has symptoms and you've been in close contact with them since their symptoms started or during the 48 hours before they started
- someone in your childcare or support bubble tested positive and you've been in close contact with them since they had the test or in the 48 hours before their test
- you've been told you've been in contact with someone who tested positive – find out what to do if you're told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace or the NHS COVID-19 app

Parent Questionnaires

School Meals
