

'NURSERY RHYME CHALLENGE'




This week is week 2 of the 'Nursery Rhyme Challenge'; the children have had fun learning the words and actions to 'Two Little Dicky Birds'.

NURSERY CLOSED

SCHOOL MEALS/FREE SCHOOL MEALS

From September 2021, children who are moving into Year 3 will no longer receive the Universal Free School Meals. This will mean that their school meals will need paying for (£2.25 per day/£11.25 per week) unless they are entitled to free school meals. If your child is in Year 2 and you think you may be eligible for free school meals, please collect a form from the office.

CURRENT YEAR 6

If your child is in Year 6 and currently receives free school meals, it is important that you contact North Lincolnshire Council to register free school meals for your child going up to secondary school as soon as possible.
