## COVID UPDATE

Some parents expressed concerns about the safety of their children at school following the notification of our Covid-19 case earlier this week. I am pleased to say that the steps the staff take to keep everyone safe in school (wearing visors, facemasks, social distancing and restricted numbers in all areas) means that there have been no further cases related to this incident. None of the isolating staff members has developed any symptoms, which shows us how effective these measures are in restricting the spread of the virus. I would like to thank the staff for their continuing vigilance and determination to keep on providing education to our young people in quite challenging circumstances!

I would also like to thank the growing number of parents and carers who have started to wear face coverings when on our site.

I would also like to stress that we follow Government and Public Health guidelines to the letter when dealing with any Covid-19 cases in school. We have a number of phone conversations with them to discuss the situation, and officials then advise us on what measures to put in place and who should isolate.

## NHS COVID-19

The NHS Covid-19 contact tracing app launched on 24th September and is available to download for Android and iPhone.

The app will alert people when they have been near someone who has tested positive for coronavirus, allow people to check their symptoms, book a test and 'check-in' to places they visit using a QR code system.

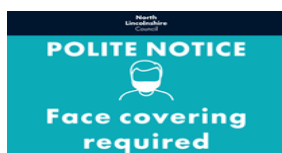
