## 'HELLO YELLOW DAY'

Oasis Academy Henderson Avenue is taking part in 'Hello Yellow' on **FRIDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2018** to show young people they are not alone with their mental health. Pupils are invited to wear yellow on this day and share mental health messages to spread the word that whatever you are going through you can talk to someone if you are struggling to cope.

Did you know that **three** children in every classroom have a diagnosable mental health condition?

### **Why does our work matter?**

- **1 in 10** children and young people, aged 5-16, suffer from a diagnosable mental health problem such as depression, anxiety or an eating disorder. That's around 3 children in every classroom.
- **10%** of young people deliberately harm themselves regularly.
- **3/4** of long-lasting mental ill health starts before the age of 18.

**There will be no charge for the children to wear yellow on this day!**
