## URGENT NOTICE REGARDING THE USE OF THE CAR PARK

Please be advised that if you collect your child by car at 11.45am or drop your child off for Nursery at 12.30pm the car park must only be used if there are available spaces to park your vehicle. Please **DO NOT** park any vehicles on double yellow lines, in areas where a car parking space is not marked or in the disabled bays (unless a blue badge is held), this makes it unsafe for pedestrians in the car park.

We need to ensure that emergency vehicles can access the site at all times and it has become apparent that some vehicles are parked irresponsibly and are blocking access.

We request that if you are unable to walk from home to collect your child, please park your vehicle on Henderson Avenue or at Sainsbury's; it is only a short walk into the academy.

If parking of vehicles does not improve over the next couple of weeks, we will have no alternative but to lock the car park during these times in order to keep our children safe.
