JEWELLERY

Jewellery is not permitted, except for children with pierced ears who may wear **studs only** on those days when they do not have swimming or P.E. Earrings must be removed for P.E. lessons and swimming lessons (because of this it is advisable for children to have their ears pierced at the beginning of the Summer holidays). If a child's ears have very recently been pierced, they may wear their studs for P.E., provided that they are covered with tape by parents/carers before they come to the Academy. Once the lesson is over, they may remove the tape.

A normal watch may be worn once a child is able to use it correctly. This must be removed for P.E. lessons.
