As an academy we have set ourselves the challenge of raising as much money as possible towards buying new books for all children to have access to within class and in our school library.

We have been in touch with Usborne books who have very kindly said that for whatever money we raise they will top this up with another **60%**. When we achieve our target this will give us an amazing £1000 to spend on buying brand new books that all children in the academy will benefit from.

In order for us to achieve our goal, we are going to hold a sponsored read during the week beginning 23rd April 2018. In school, we **pledge** that every child in EYFS and KS1 will listen to or read 10 books during that week and KS2 will read 20 minutes every day. Any reading the children do at home will also count towards their personal and class target.

As an Academy, we value your continued support and it is incredibly important to us. All we ask is that you support us by pledging to donate at least £1 per child for them to take part. SUMMER DRESS CODE

Please find below a reminder of our summer dress code:

- Blue & white or red & white gingham dresses.
- Navy blue Oasis sweatshirts or cardigans.
- Black, dark blue or grey tailored shorts, skirts, pinafores or trousers.
- White polo shirts with short or long sleeves, NOT straps and bare backs— to protect shoulders and arms from the sun and also because we believe in dressing modestly.
- Sun hats are allowed whilst in the playground and on the field but not in the school building.
- Proper shoes (not trainers) and sandals (not flip flops or heels for obvious safety reasons); trainers are not recommended for day-to-day school wear, but need to be brought in for PE.

We also recommend that children wear sun hats or baseball caps which must be removed on entering the building; if sun cream is needed this **MUST** be applied before the children come to school.
