SUMMER DRESS CODE

Please find below a reminder of our summer dress code:

- Blue & white or red & white gingham dresses.
- Navy blue Oasis sweatshirts or cardigans.
- Black, dark blue or grey tailored shorts, skirts, pinafores or trousers.
- White polo shirts with short or long sleeves, NOT straps and bare backs—to protect shoulders and arms from the sun and also because we believe in dressing modestly.
- Sun hats are allowed whilst in the playground and on the field but not in the school building.
- Proper shoes (not trainers) and sandals (not flip flops or heels for obvious safety reasons); trainers are not recommended for day-to-day school wear, but need to be brought in for PE.

Sun cream MUST be applied before the children come to school. Children may also bring a small water bottle (named) which can be re-filled during the day.
