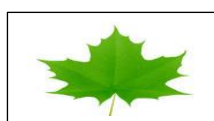

BUILDING SITES

In recent weeks, children from O.A.H.A and from other schools in the local area have been playing on a building site (ONGO new housing development) on Davy Avenue. They are hanging around on the site and some children are climbing ladders and physically knocking walls down. They then wait for the walls to be rebuilt and then return and knock them down again.

The Police and ONGO (housing) are treating this extremely seriously as it is very dangerous and the children are causing criminal damage. Some names have been put forward and the parents of those children will be receiving letters from ONGO, as their own house could be at risk as this behaviour by their children breaks the tenancy agreement.

The Police are making sure they have more officers visiting the site and have asked if we could remind all children about the danger of building sites, especially with the warm weather and long weekend coming up.
