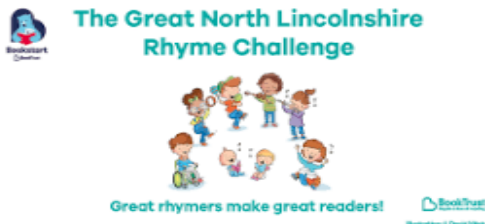
SPORTS DAY 2018
