BOOK SHOP – YEAR 1 AND 2

We are pleased to announce that our bookshop will be opening on Friday 8th June 2018. We are opening the bookshop in order to raise reading standards, promote the love of reading and also to help you with the cost of buying good quality books for your children to read at home. It is also a good opportunity for children to learn about and understand the value of money and that if you want something nice you cannot always buy it straight away but have to save up.

All children in Years 1 and 2 will automatically become a member of the bookshop and will each have a passbook. The bookshop will be open each week. Children may bring bookshop money and their passbook **on Fridays only**; any amount of money from 50p upwards may be paid in. During the day, your child will have the opportunity to go to the bookshop and pay in their money. Once children have saved £2, they can spend their money on a book of their choice from the shop. Money received and spent will be recorded in their passbook.

FOUNDATION 1 RHYME CHALLENGE



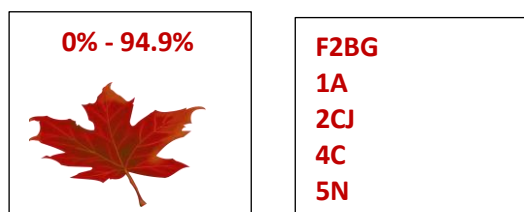
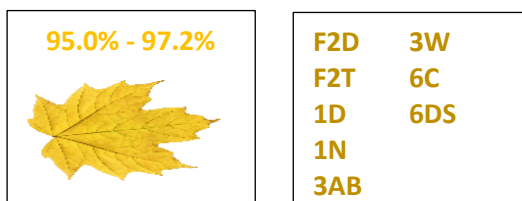
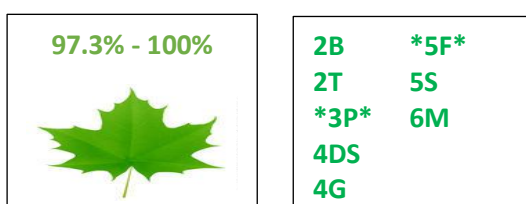
