ONE OASIS GLOBAL DAY

On **Friday 3'^d March 2017** the children in our academy will be participating in the first annual One Oasis Global Day. We will be joining all of the other 46 academies in raising money to help Oasis set up their first academy outside of the UK in Uganda – Oasis Musoto.

The aim through fundraising in all 47 academies is for Oasis Academy Musoto to become an all-through teacher training school, thereby improving the standard of education for many more children in Uganda.

Any money we raise throughout the week will go towards helping:

- 1. Continue to teach the children in Musoto.
- 2. Employ new teachers as the school grows.
- 3. Build a new toilet block, which is needed for the school to gain official registration.

Why Musoto, Uganda?

- a) Classroom sizes in local schools are in excess of 150 children to one teacher and education is of a very low quality, being delivered by poorly trained staff.
- Few pupils actually complete their primary education, with very few going on to complete a secondary education.
- Musoto is a very deprived community, children are malnourished, vulnerable to forced labour, early marriage and trafficking.
